



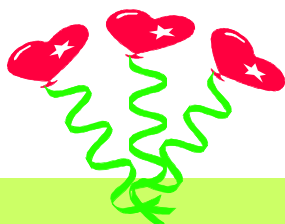

Stanford Test 10 & OLSAT



Spring time is the time when teachers and students all over the nation are preparing for standardized testing. Agape Academy's teachers and students are also gearing up for this event. During the week of **March 15 - 19**, we will test students in Kindergarten-5 through 5th grade. Testing will begin promptly at 9:00 AM each morning, so please make plans to have your child in class on time. Early morning PE classes will be canceled due to the testing schedule.

Please Remember: Students that are tardy or absent must have a doctor's excuse to make up a

missed section of their test. (see AA policy manual)

Breakfast is considered the most important meal of the day and is essential in the academic success of a student. Therefore, please make sure your child has a hearty breakfast and an encouraging sendoff each morning. Students will receive a snack each morning during their break period to help their focus.

Agape Academy has selected the Stanford 10 Achievement Test for our students. This year in addition to the Stanford 10, the students will receive the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test

(OLSAT 8). The OLSAT 8 is composed of four components: Comprehension, verbal reasoning, figural reasoning and quantitative reasoning. By assessing student's thinking skills, the OLSAT provides an awareness of a student's relative strengths and weakness and will enable educators to better understand the attributes that students bring to the task of learning. This information allows the classroom teacher to use methods of teaching that will enhance the student's strengths while supporting their learning needs.
